More than 50 volunteers to improve Missoula during United Way Day of Action on Friday, June 18

Missoula – United Way of Missoula County is spurring volunteers into action across the community on Friday, June 18, to give back through hands-on “Day of Action” projects that focus on United Way’s work in education, financial stability, and health. This annual event mobilizes the caring power of volunteers to create positive community change
