More than 90 volunteers to improve Missoula during United Way Day of Action on Friday, June 24

Missoula – United Way of Missoula County is spurring volunteers into action across the community on Friday, June 24, to give back through hands-on “Day of Action” projects that focus on United Way’s work in education, financial stability, and health. This annual event mobilizes the caring power of volunteers to support positive community change.

Working with United Way partners such as Mountain Home Montana, Garden City Harvest, The Parenting Place, and the Missoula Marathon, volunteers will help weed neighborhood gardens, update landscaping, and paint. Eleven groups of volunteers will work on eight service projects throughout Missoula.

Part of an international effort, Missoula’s Day of Action is an annual event hosted by United Way each June. Stockman Bank, Parsons, Behle & Latimer, and Missoula’s Scheels are sponsoring this year’s Day of Action.
